●●●Child Raising Consultation (子ども教育相談)

Institute of Education (Phone: 382-9056)

The Institute of Education accepts consultations and provides support regarding children's mental and physical development. The issues the institute deals with are those such as listed below. The services are provided free of charge; the privacy is strictly secured.

- School refusals
- Issues concerning school life (bullying, neglect/maladjustment, depression of school performance, etc.)
- Mental development (delay of speech development, signs of autism, lack of composure, awkwardness, etc.)
- Issues concerning the personality/behavior (peculiarity, difficulty in expressing oneself, railings/violent language, or physical violence)

Institute of Education (Phone: 382-9056)

The Institute of Education promotes improvement of school environment for early treatment and prevention of school refusals by facilitating educational counseling at school. An example of such activity is the school counselors and mental counselors dispatched from the institute and stationed at each elementary and junior high school. ●●●Administrative Educational Consultation (教育行政相談)

Institute of Education (Phone: 382-9056)

Administrative educational consultation is an activity for collecting and properly reflecting opinions the opinions of guardians and the citizens concerning the educational administration.

“Administrative educational consultation” might be an unfamiliar term. While the “educational counseling” refers to the consultation and consultation with respect to individual children between the guardians and school teachers or staffs of the Institute of Education, “the administrative educational consultation” concerns every aspect of administration and various administrative issues regarding education that are subject to the board of education.

Application procedures

On the screening

The decisions of acceptance or rejection are made on the application documents, school records, personality, the difficulty of expenses, and additional materials.
